Re: College Reports / Getting Scores

1. Exams are just around the corner. You are well prepared! During the next few weeks, get lots of rest, and have fun with the exams (really, aside from the stress, there are many memorable and enjoyable moments).

2. Congratulations to our graduating seniors! We all wish you the best with your future endeavors. **Seniors, here is how you can report your scores to colleges and universities ...**

(a) If you want your **official IB transcript** to go to your college, you must make the request now. Simply include the following information in an email and submit to the IB office: fhs.ib@bvvsd.org

Name of United States or Canadian college or university:

College city and state/province:

Unfortunately, IBO has restrictions on transcript reporting. A candidate is not allowed to send a transcript request to more than one United States university. There is a hard deadline for making a request: June 30, 2015 (Note, this deadline is before scores are released.)

(b) Requests to send official College Board (AP) scores is done when students complete the admin portion of answer sheets on exam day (additional reporting options are described in the AP Student Pack, given on exam day).

3. Getting Results. Both IB and AP scores will be released in early July (historically July 6th). For IB scores, the process is simple; go to the website listed below and use your **Personal Code** and **PIN** to logon. (Your personal code and PIN were given to you by one of your teachers; contact the IB office if you do not have them.)
